

COURSE: INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS LAW

Course Objectives:

The course is aimed at introducing business students to a wide range of problems involving International Trade, Licensing and Investment Issues. International legal aspects of trade, development and economic as well as technical, social and cultural cooperation will be examined. The resolution of international disputes through litigation, and arbitration and the role of international lawyers and the ethical standards and rules which apply to them will also be considered. The international legal order will be reviewed – customary international law, treaties, the extraterritorial application of domestic law as well as international institutions such as WTO and the IMF.
